



FMA ALLIANCE PRIDE IN PARTNERSHIP AWARD

Established in 2000 to honor physicians and their spouses who, through their volunteer efforts, have together made significant contributions both to organized medicine as well as to the healthcare and/or health education of the citizens of the communities in which they reside.

PROTOCOLS:

1. Both the physician and spouse must be members of the FMA and FMA Alliance
2. The parties nominated must be a married couple
3. The physician and spouse must have both evidenced singular, outstanding contributions to organized medicine through their activity with the county medical society and county alliance and/or the FMA and FMA Alliance. It is not a requirement that either party should have been county or state officers in the medical society and alliance.
4. The physician and spouse must have both evidenced singular, outstanding contributions to their local community (whether jointly or separately) in the areas of health care, health education, or legislative activity dealing with the health and well being of the citizens of their community.

This award is meant to honor the partnership of the medical marriage and the great good that so often arises from this union and that is so often overlooked. This should be the highest award that our organizations bestow on their members, and those so honored should reflect the best that medicine has to offer.

The current FMA Alliance Awards Committee will judge the submissions.
